

Census 2020: Count All Kids!

Did you know children under the age of 5 are the most likely group to be undercounted on the census?

Undercounting individuals could cost the state millions of dollars in federal allocations for many programs that benefit children and families.



It is important that each person filling out the Census form counts EVERY CHILD living at that address, including babies.

Children who are missed in the 2020 Census miss an opportunity to be counted for 10 years - most of their childhood.
