## Statement from Bharti Wahi, Executive Director of CDF-MN:

We stand in solidarity with our community today. The horrific killing of George Floyd at the hands of members of the Minneapolis Police Department is a shocking and painful reminder of how systems are often designed to hurt Black and brown people. The violence and destruction in our cities is a loud cry of visceral pain, anger and fear.
